1. The Prophetic plan of God for the future:

(*please see diagram)

- What you believe will determine your place in God's plan
- We're living in the 'Church Age'

John 14:1-3: "... I go to my Father's house to prepare..."

I Thess. 4:13-18: "...The Lord will descend from Heaven..."

- The Judgment Seat of Christ will 'cover' all Christians only...
- Live a consecrated life now: Lay up for yourself treasures in Heaven

2. The Second Coming of Christ: (*please see diagram)

Matthew 24:9,11

- The Tribulation Period: 7 Year period of Time

Matthew 24:15-21

- The worst time in human history

Matthew 24:22,29

Matthew 25

- The Judgment of the Nations and establishment of 1000 year Kingdom
- People 'left behind' in the Tribulation will be given a chance to accept the Lord or reject Him.

- God does not nor will not force us to accept Jesus as our Savior: We have a Free will.

Revelation 4 Jesus is presented in another way

- The world will say "Peace, Peace..."

3. What will happen to the World when all the Christians are gone?

- One World Government: Global Alliance

Revelation 6:3: War – The worst war in human history

Revelation 6:8: Worldwide Famine

Revelation 6:9: The saints who accepted Christ after the Rapture will be "clothed in white robes"

Revelation 6:12: Earthquakes, the earth will be shaken and nearly destroyed (All of this will occur in the first 21 months of the Tribulation)

Revelation 8:7: Holocaust-like events

Revelation 13: Government will begin the "Mark of the Beast" (during the middle of the Tribulation)

- Nothing will be done to resolve all of these horrific events without God
- In the Tribulation, the anti-Christ will deceive people; those who do not worship him will be killed.
